Collection consists of 246, mostly, 8" x 10" black and white silver gelatin prints of photographs of historic Louisiana architecture, principally in New Orleans. The prints were collected by Thompson and include such well known photographers as Charles Franck, Frances Benjamin Johnston, and Wood "Pops" Whitesell. Thompson was a New Orleans public relations figure who collected the photographs in connection with his work.
